

# Lukey Luke flat out and giving back..!

If you haven't seen Australia's premier no. 1 Stunt performer and on-track entertainer 'Lukey' Luke this year then you're not getting out enough. Lukey's performances impress even people with no interest in adrenaline or extreme sports. His shows combine flat-out, sideways burnouts, mixed with tail whipping stoppies and vertical, no-hand circle wheelies. All this in a confined up-close and personal area where the audience can almost touch Lukey piloting his Triumph Street Triple R to its limits. What's impressive is that apart from a few small personal modifications to the controls etc, his Triumph is basically the same as you can buy off the showroom floor 'out of the box'.

In a recent interview, Lukey revealed that he has performed at over 30 Motorcycle, Car and popular events so far in 2011. His most recent appearances include the Australian Teen Expo 2011, Australian Drift Grand Prix and the ever popular Calder Park Drag Event. On the weekend Lukey was the main attraction at the Braaap Adrenaline Sports Festival on the streets of Frankston which attracted more than 7000 people. Lukey's passion for life and his living is contagious. "If I'm not travelling around the country most weekends, I'm out at my 'spot' trying new tricks. I've never been so busy, but I'm absolutely loving it!" Lukey is a fun-loving and passionate bloke, who loves his bike's and is happy to have a chat with anyone at his events

Most notably, Lukey has also been giving back to his beloved motorcycle community with recent performances at charity events such as the annual Pink Ribbon Ride and inspiring troubled teens at Caulfield Park Community School where he enforced the importance of staying in school and the role it's played in his life. "I love giving back. Not only to the motorcycle world (which has been so good to me over the years) but the community too. It's great to be a part of, and have something exciting I can give to charity".



Lukey is able to fuel his passion with the support of his committed sponsoring partners, which include: Major sponsor Triumph Motorcycles Australia, Globe, RST, Dunlop, KBC, Hart and Huntington and Sartso jeans. When asked about 2012, and will we continue to see him on a Triumph, he's clear: "Absolutely! I love my Triumphs and I wouldn't ride anything else! Not only are the bikes amazing, reliable and nimble, but all the guys at Triumph Australia are a pleasure to deal with! It's like being part of the family and I wouldn't have it any other way... I'm so excited about next year and what's to come, I already have a huge schedule booked and lots of new plans in the works".

Throughout his crazy and busy schedule Lukey still manages to cut laps regularly at Philip Island and Broadford Raceway with some seriously quick race pace. Many people ask him if Triumph gave him his Triumph Daytona 675 track bike? "They didn't need to! When I was originally sponsored by Triumph I already had it. 4 years later and I still have it! Like I said, I love Triumph and their bikes. They're such reliable machines. I mean if you've seen any of my shows you know what I put them through and they never miss a beat".

You've still got time to see and meet Lukey in 2012. Coming up this month, he's performing at the Auto Fair on November 12, the Fuchs Triple Crown Final at Calder Park on the 19<sup>th</sup>, the Sydney Motorcycle Expo 25-27<sup>th</sup> and he finishes the year with the Braaap Devonport Street Party on the December 3rd, and the Annual Melbourne Toy Run December 11.
